**August 18, 2020, Darby, MT:** The Steiner Rodeo Family from Texas, Taylor Sheridan and Bosque Ranch Productions have announced the debut of the Yellowstone Riggin' Rally in Darby to be held Labor Day, Monday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The Rally will include the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association, the top 24 Bareback Riders from the PRCA, a \$30,000 purse and attendance by some cast members of the Taylor Sheridan and Bosque Ranch Productions series, Yellowstone. The Cowboy Channel will be filming the Rally for broadcast on their network.

The event will be held at the Richard Cromwell Memorial Rodeo Grounds in Darby. Gates will open for attendance at 4:00 p.m. and the Performance will begin at 6:00 p.m. Tickets sales will be limited to the first 1,300 purchasers. General Admission tickets can be purchased at the gate for \$30 or in advance for \$25, at the 406 Saloon, Murdoch's or online at <a href="https://www.406Saloon.com">www.406Saloon.com</a>. Reserved Seats are priced at \$35 at the gate or \$30 in advance, and can be purchased at Darby Wine and Spirits. Kids 3 and under are admitted free. Tickets will go on sale Friday, August 21st.

The Rally will be preceded by a series of community events and entertainment in Darby throughout the Labor Day Weekend. The Darby Rodeo Association will be a beneficiary of a portion of the sales of tickets, liquor and vendor proceeds. Cal Ruark, President of the Darby Rodeo Association expressed, "I was blown away when I received a call from Bobby Steiner who I have followed for years. But when he said he wanted to bring this event to Darby Montana because he recognizes the Darby Rodeo Association and Rodeo Grounds as top notch and home of the Best Little Bull Riding...well I was speechless. I said yes of course! And out of the blue, here we are."
