DRA SALUTES OUR YETERANS


"A Veteran is someone who, at one point in their life was willing to write a check for an amount up to and including their life, made payable to the United States of America.

DRA ROYALTY REPORT



DID YOU KNOW THAT...

Did you know that, contrary to belief, no bands or ties are placed on the testicles of Bulls and Broncs to make them buck? They buck merely with a Flank Strap.

Did you know that back on October 26, 1991 in Central Point Oregon, Wade Leslie, a horse farrier, scored a perfect 100 point Bull Ride? He and the Bull, Wolfman Skoal, each scored 100 points. It was the first, and only, 100-point ride in PRCA history.

Did you know that two-time PBR world champion JB Mauney has won over \$6 million riding bulls in his career? That's right \$6,000,000!

Did you know that Ronnie "Punch" Rossen from Broadus MT was the World Champion Bull Rider in 1961 and 1966? He died at a Sr Pro Rodeo event in Colorado in 1991. The Bull he was riding stepped on his chest after his eight second ride and he died of related injuries. He was 54 years old and he had the winning ride for the night.

Did you know that the RCA (Rodeo Cowboy Association) was in Darby Montana in 1947 and was the precursor to what is now the PRCA (Professional Rodeo Cowboy Association)?
